Meeting Context

- First executive council meeting for the semester
- Focus: Council structure, accountability, portfolio updates, motions to amend constitution/roles, event planning, and operational logistics

Introductions & Icebreaker

- Everyone introduced themselves: name, program, year, and country they'd live in if not Canada
- Mix of second, third, fourth, and fifth-year students; roles include president, VP academics, communications, programming, finance, wellness, etc.
- Icebreaker question: which country would you live in?

Accountability & Constitution Updates

- Need for clear accountability standards due to past issues with uneven workload
- Monthly portfolio meetings required for all execs (already in constitution, just emphasizing)
- Attendance policy clarified: missing two meetings with/without regret triggers consequences
- Absence form created for excused absences
- Some roles missing from constitution—plan to update and add all current positions
- Motions to formally update constitution and roles to be voted on

Council Structure & Role Changes

- Budget constraints mean fewer events and positions this year
- Proposed changes by portfolio:
 - Academics: reduce to one CAP rep
 - Communications: reduce from six to four production coordinators; specializations (video/graphic) to be decided later
 - Finance: possible sponsorship coordinator role, but may be shared responsibility

- Student Support/Programming: reduce from four to three; keep first year rep, add programming coordinators, remove wellness commissioners
- Presidential: remove two exec roles (advocacy, external affairs)
- Discussion on maintaining first year rep role for engagement
- Suggestion to use committees/volunteer roles for short-term projects (e.g., Toronto trip, sponsorship)

Applications & Hiring

- Google Forms applications set up for most positions; edits needed for role changes
- Timeline: applications to go out ASAP, two weeks for responses, regroup if not enough applicants
- First council meeting for new hires planned for mid-October (after entrepreneurship event)
- Availability spreadsheet for scheduling meetings

Operations & Tools

- Microsoft To Do used for task tracking; encourage everyone to check off completed tasks
- Exec availability spreadsheet in shared drive—highlight unavailable times
- Each portfolio to hold monthly meetings and keep simple bullet-point notes in shared drive
- Trying out Cluely for AI note-taking; Otter.ai as backup option

Motions & Voting

- Motions to update constitution and council structure:
 - Rename "associate VP" roles for clarity
 - Reduce communications coordinators from six to four; specializations to be decided
 - Student support/programming: reduce from four to three, change roles to one first year rep and two programming coordinators (debate over number of first year reps)
 - Remove exec roles from presidential portfolio
 - Academics: reduce to one CAP rep
 - Update constitution to accurately reflect all current roles

- Voting process: hands raised for/against/abstain; all motions passed with some discussion and one objection on first year rep numbers

Portfolio & Event Updates

- Fifth annual Career Conference planned for October 17, 2pm
 - Alumni panels from various industries (marketing, PR, music, NYT, etc.)
 - Theme: "Career Challah"
 - Companies involved: CIBC, Spotify, Bell Media, Freedom of the Wave
- Mediation Journal moving to a website hosted by Western Libraries; archives to be uploaded
- Western Continuing Studies event: November 13, 5-7pm, promoting diploma programs
- Portfolio-building workshops planned, based on student survey; to be advertised at Career Conference, start in November
- Makerspace tour event: two options (prototype pitch session or hands-on workshop in digital/woodworking space); group prefers hands-on workshop with creative incentives

Communications & Website

- Website homepage completed; Meet the Team and First Year Survival Kit in progress
- Biweekly posts planned for Instagram to keep account active
- Exec hiring posts to be shared multiple times
- Suggestions for more personal/creative content (e.g., meet the execs videos, summer recaps, music recommendations)
